Guidance (Discipline) Policy

Oakbrook Child Development Center does not believe in corporal punishment outside of the home environment, therefore, we will not spank a child even with parents permission. Our employees have been instructed never to spank, slap, shake or jerk children. That will do nothing that could be construed as physical punishment.

We will use behavior modification methods, such as assertive discipline, in order to change a child's undesirable behavior, time out in the classroom or in the office will be used if the child's disruptive behavior continues. We will use discipline in a positive way in order to help a child learn self-control.

Parents who do not discipline their children at home, make it very difficult for them when they are placed in a structured classroom environment. We are willing to work with the parents, but if a child can not adjust to a classroom environment within a reasonable period of time and takes more than his/her share of the teachers time, we reserve the right to ask the child be removed from our school. I understand and accept the discipline policy of Oakbrook Child Development Center.
